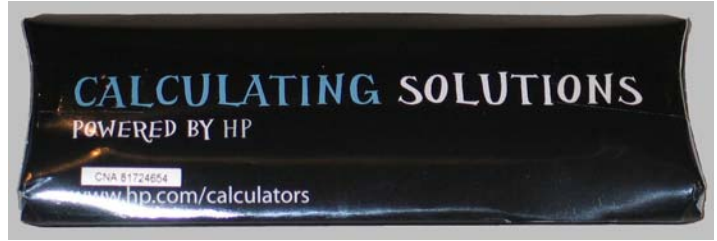


Fig. 1 – Quick Calc Carrying case “back”.



Fig. 2 – Quick Calc Carrying case “front”.

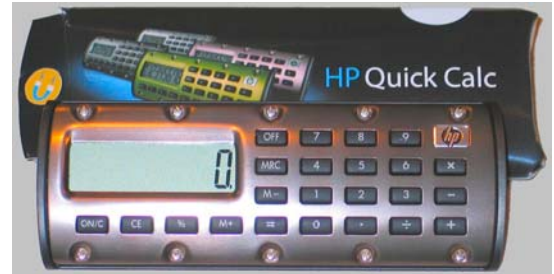


Fig. 3 – Quick Calc on top of carrying case.

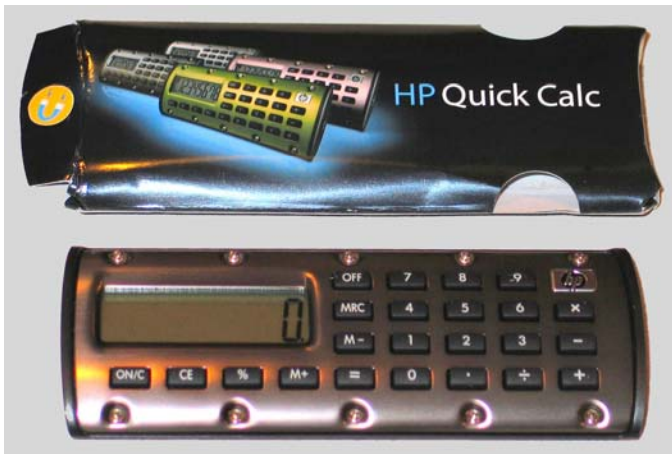


Fig. 4 – Quick Calc front with carrying case.



Fig. 5 – quick Calc back with carrying case.

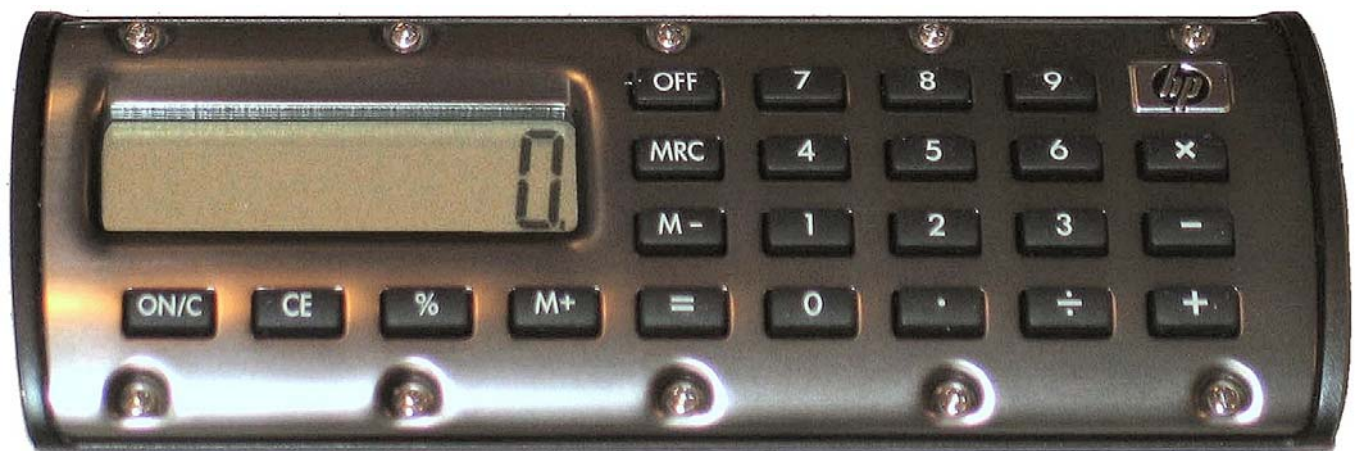


Fig. 6 – HP’s new Quick Calc eight digit Four Function Calculator. Contrary to the specifications the Quick Calc does not do square roots, is not algebraic, (i.e. $1+2x3=9$, not 7), has no last answer function, and does not have parentheses. See HP’s official specifications on the next page.
